At this stage, the human is becoming less dependent on its parents. It is starting to develop into an adult which can be a challenging time.

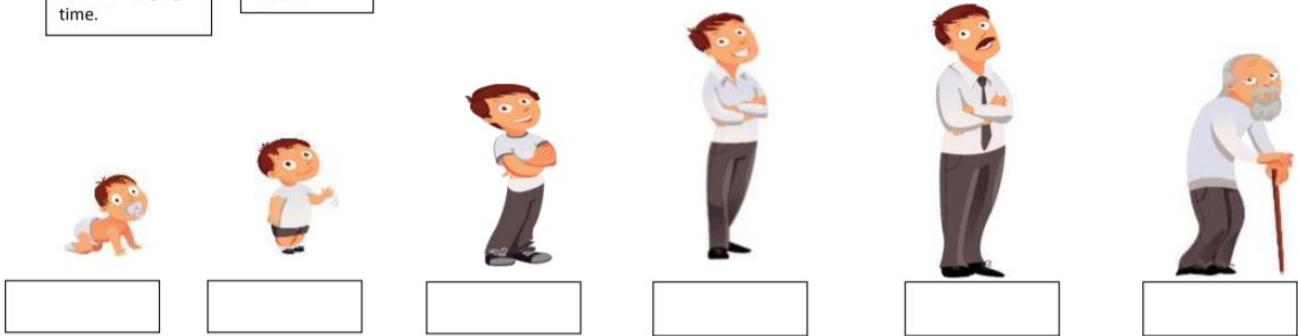
The human is now able to fully walk and talk. It is able to go to the toilet unaided and can feed itself without support.

This is the stage where a human is completely independent. It may have its own children.

A human is learning to walk and talk. The human can feed itself with support but still needs nappies changed and has a high level of dependency on adults.

A baby is born after leaving the womb where it has stayed for 9 months. It is completely dependent on adults for survival.

This is the stage where life can become quite challenging. The human isn't as fit as it used to be and finds everyday chores like shopping more difficult the older it gets.
