I wanted to send another update to keep you informed.

### **Remote Learning**

Teachers have been working hard this week to record all their live lessons - This allows you to watch them back at another time. I'm sure some of you have enjoyed and been learning from lessons yourselves!

As the weeks go on it is **so important to keep your children in the school day routine**. Even if you are not going outside, it is important that children get dressed each morning and are 'Ready for School' at 9am. Teachers post a daily timetable onto Google Classroom – this tells the children what work do and when. Please encourage your children to follow these timetables as if they were at school.

**Teachers expect work to be completed by the end of the school day**. We have seen some children's work being handed in at 10pm or even later – All Primary-aged children should be in bed well before this time!

If work is handed in late – teachers will be unable to mark it. We understand that things happen and there may be times when this is difficult, if this is the case; please email your child's teacher and let them know.

### **Parental Support**

We know you love helping your children to complete their home learning and whilst explaining the work to them is fine – **please do not do it for them!** It is difficult for teachers to mark and assess if children haven't completed the work by themselves.
